Introduction

In this book I will share with you the encounters and discoveries that I have experienced in my journey with the Holy Spirit into the heart of Jesus our Majestic King. These encounters began early in life as God drew me into relationship with Him. It is my desire to share with you some of the encounters, wisdom, revelation and experiences that I have had with The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. As you read about these experiences they can become your inheritance. Your faith, your hunger and your response to His Presence will escort you into this delightful relationship. Richness of spirit, profound intimacy, wisdom and revelation of God's Presence await you. I impart these to you today as a prophetic voice of the Lord Jesus.

In broader terms, legacy is what you have also inherited as a Believer in Christ. Jesus has provided you spiritual access into the Throne Room of God. What you experience with God is also your legacy. This book will propel you into living in the fullness of your God given inheritance.

The purpose of this book is not to present a Biblical Thesis on the subject of supernatural encounters between God and His people. Some will demand that and consequently, feel that what I share is focused on experiences and therefore very subjective. In their minds a subjective sharing of personal experiences has little value to the Body of Christ. I understand this position and will never make a great issue about it but simply say that it is a common world view. This world view is well entrenched in many minds because the majority of western thinking has been deeply influenced by the Age of Reasoning that emerged in Europe and its colonies during the late 1600's and into the 1700's.

An Age of Enlightenment (or simply the Enlightenment or Age of Reason) was a cultural movement of intellectuals in 18th-century Europe, that sought to mobilize the power of reason, in order to reform society and advance knowledge. It promoted science and intellectual interchange and opposed superstition,[1] intolerance and abuses in church and state.

It continues to cast a shadow of unbelief over western societies. Many that hear of this book or read it will cast me off as a mystic, a person out of touch with reality or simply a religious man with delusions but I am none of these. It is so refreshing to minister to people in nations where people have not been indoctrinated in this world view and philosophical reasoning all through their academic years.

Yes, when you go into a primitive African village where people are in darkness, you deal with a lot of bizarre things. Demonic powers, superstitions, witch doctors and raw sinfulness will smack you right in the face. But when you preach about God's redemptive plan and the reality of His Presence, these people understand God from a supernatural perspective that is rare in western nations.

I met one pastor in Central Mozambique, Africa who at the age of ten years began to have Angelic visits. He and his family knew absolutely nothing about God but an Angel would come and instruct this young man about the Kingdom of God. This Angel after several visits took him away in the spirit and showed him Heaven and then Hell. This young boy chose to serve Jesus as His Lord. He told his Mother all that had been happening and she began to walk with him about two miles to a little mud wall church every Sunday.

It is my conviction that the Body of Christ needs to experience the reality of God's Presence in tangible Biblical ways. When Jesus said in John 8:32, "And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" He clearly mandated the necessity of Biblical Truth being the foundation of what we experience with God. It is my opinion that, dreams, visions, Angelic encounters, prophetic revelation and personal relationship with God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit is established by God. By His initiative He has made this possible through faith in His Son the Lord Jesus Christ. He invites us to know Him personally and in tangible ways.

In other words, experiencing His Presence is far more than intellectual knowledge of God's truth. Knowing His Truth includes both Biblical knowledge and experiencing His Presence within that Biblical truth. What I will share in my personal testimony of encounters with God is based in a Biblical relationship with Him. When He looks at you, He looks at you with immense faith, hope and love. I have looked into His eyes and been overwhelmed by the deepness, the purity, the immense qualities that flow from His eyes. His eyes are the windows of His Spirit and they express profound faith, hope and love. Before He comes again, He will restore

these attributes to many of His Sons and Daughters. Many are wanting the gifts of the Holy Spirit and they are absolutely necessary but so is the fruit of the Holy Spirit. Inner Awakenings:

Born Again by the Spirit.

I slipped into the church pew with my Mother and Dad and sat down in this little Free Methodist church feeling uncertain, yet hopeful and very hungry for God. The song service began with some songs I recognized from my childhood days. However many of the songs were new and created an atmosphere of deeper longing and invitation. Twenty minutes or so of worship was followed up by the Pastor asking if there were any testimonies this evening. This was a little strange to me but I had heard some of this kind of congregational expression in a few other venues, so I listened with great interest to what was happening in that worship service.

I was seventeen years of age and a few months short of my eighteenth birthday. Most of the people were old enough to be my grand parents. There were a handful of young people in the church around my age but what was being shared by these older people galvanized my attention. Some stood to their feet with tears running down their cheeks and shared about Jesus walking with them through the past week. How He had spoken to them as they prayed and read His word. How His power had touched them. They shared how He had helped them through difficult times during their journey of life.

During their testimonies, they would tell of how they had come into salvation earlier in life. The words they shared created an atmosphere within the church. For the first time in my life attending any other form of church, I actually felt the Presence of God. I longed for what they spoke of and experienced. My heart pounded within me. I was flooded with desire to know God in the way they knew Him. This was real. The atmosphere and Presence of God was close to me and I knew it. Each week, I would return because of what I felt and for what I longed for. Within a month or two there was a change of Pastors and we soon were introduced to a Lady Pastor. Her first name was Beth. She had travelled as an evangelist for several years and carried a deep compassion for the lost. I was lost but I was also searching. Almost every service she would invite people forward for prayer. Sometimes, I would go forward but usually felt awkward and did not know how to pray. I did not have a personal relationship with the Lord yet, so these prayer times were only gestures that I was making towards God. One Sunday morning, I felt deeply convicted, hungry and desperate for God. At the conclusion of that service, I did not go forward for prayer because my hands were gripped to the back of the pew in front of me. I longed to go for prayer but could not break myself from the fear that had come over me. The service ended and we started to leave the building.

This dear Pastor made her way to the only entrance out of the church and waited there; I am sure for me. She of course was shaking the hands of everyone leaving the service that morning. When she shook my hand, she did not let go. She looked me straight in the eye and told me one of the most liberating truths that could have graced my heart at that time. I lacked certainty and courage. She told me that I could invite Jesus into my life anyplace, at any time and that it was the most important decision I could make in this life. I thanked her for telling me that and said “ I would give that some thought.”

The very next night, I was in my room doing homework from school. My heart was restless and soon my thoughts drifted away to a song we had sung there in the church. I began to sing what I knew of the words. It spoke of Jesus and how He had taken our place on the cross to provide forgiveness and opened a way to have relationship with God. I felt deeply moved emotionally. I was so aware of my sinful empty heart. As tears ran down my face, I asked Jesus to come into My life, to forgive me and lead me from that time forward. Several things happened in that room that night. A heavy sense of guilt lifted from my heart. I knew Jesus had forgiven me. I felt the Holy Spirit in that room like never before. His Presence was tangible, real and powerful. I laid on my bed in reverent awe, joy and amazement at what I was experiencing. That was the beginning of my relationship with God the Father, Jesus the Son and the precious Holy Spirit. I was deeply satisfied.

My life changed. His truth began to refine me. My heart was alive, vibrant, vulnerable and yet eager to follow Him. Each Sunday, I would attend the same services. I soon attempted to share with these precious people what I had experienced. I bravely tried to stand like the veterans did and share my testimony. But I could only blurt out a few words and then I would begin to cry. I usually would sputter and finally sit down. The weeping before the Lord occurred during every testimony time. I would often begin to cry as I talked about what Jesus meant to me and had done for me. I knew I was born again of the Spirit through faith in Jesus as my personal Lord and Saviour.

The Holy Spirit was so real and began to lead me. He gave me a desire to go into the ministry and I started the process of training that would place me into the ministry.

These early experiences were the beginnings of a relationship with the Holy Spirit that continues to this day.
